

Abednego Benjamin White (1734 - 1819)

In the census of 1776 Abednego is 42 years old and wife Mary is 24. Two females listed as age 3 & 4.

In Prince George Co MD. in 1776, Abednego is listed as a member of the 25th Bn. of Prince George Co. Militia.

In July 1788 Abednego patented 10,000 acres of land on Indian Creek Fork of the Clinch River in Va.

In April 1790 Abednego swears before P. Wagener, clerk of Fairfax Co. VA the Following:

I Abednego White do swear that my removal into the state of VA. was with no intent of evading the Laws for preventing the further importation of slaves. Have brought no slave with me with an intent of selling nor have any of the slaves I have brought with me been imported from Africa, any of the West India Islands, since the 1st day of November 1778, so help me God. Abednego is listed in the Tax Collection Records of Prince George Co, MD in 1780-81-81-88.

In 1807 Russell County VA Personal Property Tax List, it states that Abednego White owned 3000 acres in 20 different tracts.

In 1809 Tazewell County Records it states that Abednego White owned 2600 acres in 19 different tracts.

In appraisement of Abednego Whites belongings on January 14, 1820, his sons Shadrack & Meshack are listed as Administrators of his estate. Also listed were the names of 11 slaves: Abram, Beck & child, Bet, Creaser, Reuben, Dick, Let, Brice, Milly, Patty, and Rease.
