Jiams, Jr., Plummer Jiams. 31. 463 === Last Will and Testament of Richard Ijams, Anne Arundel County, Maryland, March 30, 1747: In the name of God Amen, I Richard Iiams of Ann Arundle County in the Province of Maryland planter Being of perfect Mind and Memory and Calling to Mind the Mortality of My Body Knowing tis appointed for all men Once to Die Do Make Constitute and Ordain this my last will and Testament in the following Manner and form Imprimus I bequeath my Soul into the Hands of God that gave it me, and my Body to the earth To be buried in a Christian Like and Decent Manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter Named and Touching Such worldly goods as it hath Pleased God to bestow upon me (after my Just Debts Being paid) I Give Doveise and Dispose of them as following --- I Give and Bequeath to my Beloved Wife Eliza [Elizabeth, abbreviated] Iiams During her Natural Life all my personal Estate whatsoever Except the following Legacies provided my Said wife lives Single and remains unmarried But in Case She thinks Proper to Marry again immediately after Such Marriage or at the time of her Death I Bequeath all my personal Estate to be Equally Dovided Between my
