containing 160 acres....  
And other lands not now in question.

To have and to hold the aforesaid bargained tracts of land with all the appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining to her the said Susannah Klamm, her heirs and assigns forever, and the aforesaid John Campbell and Ellen, his wife, for and in consideration of the aforesaid sum of money, doth for themselves, their heirs, executors, administrators and assigns; covenant and agree to and with the aforesaid Susannah Klamm, her heirs and assigns against the lawful claim or claims of themselves, their heirs and assigns, and against the claims and demands of all and every other persons whomsoever, to the only proper use, behoof and enjoyment of her heirs and assigns forever.
