

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Biography

Birth and Parents

Alice MacLand was born between 1656 and 1673 from the data noted by the *Members of the National Society of Sons and Daughters of the Pilgrims*. Average year of birth would be around 1665^{[1][2]} She is the daughter of [John MacLand](#)^{[3][4]} and [Elizabeth \(___\)](#).^{[3][5]}

Alice and her children are named in the Will of her father, [John MacLand](#), dated 1 June 1705, in Isle of Wight County, Virginia.^[3] See [John MacLand Will](#).


Marriage

Alice MacLand married [William Bryan](#)^[6] born, ca. 1655. Died, ca. 1749.^{[7][8] [9]} William is the son of [John Bryan](#) and is not a Marquis.^[10]

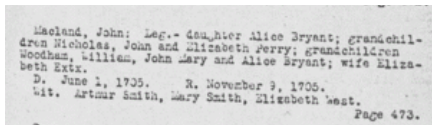
Alice MacLand Bryan passed away after 1 June 1705^{[3][11][12]} or 1729.^[1]

William Bryan came to America, settled in Isle of Wight Co, Va., afterwards he and two sons Needham and John Bryan came to North Carolina about 1722, his son William re-married in Virginia and is thought to be the ancestor of William J. Bryan.

William Bryan I. was said to have come originally from Ireland. He is buried in Pasquotank County, N. C. He married in England about 1689 Alice Needham said to be the daughter of Lord Needham, they had one son Needham Bryan born Feb'y 23rd, 1690, who came from Virginia and settled at Snowfield, Bertie Co., N. C., he md Annie Rombeau Nov. 11th, 1711. She died Jan'y 16th, 1730. Augt 24th, 1732 he married his 2nd wife Susanna Harrell. She died in 1752, then he married 3rd Sarah Woodward. They are all buried at Snowfields.

Needham Bryan and Annie Rombeau his 1st wife had one daughter and two sons, viz: (1) Rachel Bryan md William Whitfield Nov. 6th, 1741. (2) William Bryan married Elizabeth Smith (daughter of John Smith). (3) Needham Bryan md Nancy Smith, (daughter of John.)

William (son of Needham and Annie Rombeau Bryan) md 1744 Elizabeth (daughter of Elizabeth Whitfield and John Smith) issue, (1) Lewis Bryan md Nancy daughter of Major John Hinton of Raleigh. (2) William Bryan born 1747, died 1800 in Bertie Co., N. C. (3) Arthur Bryan. (4) Elizabeth Bryan. (5) Hardy Bryan. (6) Blake Bryan. (7) Esther Bryan. (8) Susanna Bryan. (9) John Bryan.

(2). William (son of William and Elizabeth Smith Bryan) md 1788 *Elizabeth Gray daughter of William Gray and wife Frances Lee. Had issue (1) Frances Lee Bryan d. u.; (2) William Bryan died young; (3) Elizabeth Smith Bryan; (4) Ann Gray Bryan; (5) Janet Smith Bryan; (6) Susanna Dosh Bryan; (7) William Gray Bryan; (8) John Stevens Bryan; (9) James Lewis Bryan.

(3) Arthur (son of William and Elizabeth Bryan) md Nancy McCullers and had one son John Arthur Bryan. All moved to Georgia.

(4) Elizabeth (daughter of William and Elizabeth Smith Bryan) md Col. Josiah Sasser, issue, (a) Mary Sasser, (b) William Sasser, (c) Blake Sasser, (d) Lewis Sasser.

* Can any of our readers give us the descendants of Lewis Bryan and wife, Nancy Hinton, daughter of Maj. John Hinton, of Wake County, N. C.

* Elizabeth Gray also descended from Anne Gray, wife of John Gray, of Bertie County, N. C., and daughter of Lewis Bryan and Elizabeth Hunter, who came to Bertie County, N. C., in 1713 from Surry County, Va. Anne Bryan was born in 1687. (Editec.)
