

Tithable Lists Prince William County 1765

The first acquisition of the Friends of the Virginia State Archives was a significant one, the papers of the Rev. Melvin Steadman. Dr. Louis H. Manarin, Virginia State Archivist, and Richard Slatten, first president of the FVSA, advanced the funds to acquire the papers for the Archives before the Friends was solvent. Among them were three 1765 Prince William tithable lists not held by the Archives. Administered by parish vestries, tithable lists were in a sense Colonial tax lists. Dettingen Parish was established in 1745 by a division of Hamilton Parish, which had formerly covered the whole of Prince William County. Above four names in one of the lists is the notation, "Dettingen Parish Tithes in Fauquier," perhaps for those whose property spanned the county line. Owing to age, to fading ink, and to bleeding, two of these lists pose difficulties in transcribing some names; readers are always cautioned to examine the originals whenever there is reason to question a spelling. The lists are published here with the kind permission of Dr. Manarin.
