



July 19, 1674. Came John Beale of Resurrection Hundred in Calvert County, Maryland, who married Joana, who was the relict of George Reade, late of the same place and county, and also the relict and executrix of Robert Tyler, late of the same place and county, and showed the Judge that the said Joana on July 30, 1674, and before the marriage with him, the said Jno. Beale, by the name of Joana Tyler, did make certain deed of trust of all her lands. etc., movables and immovables, unto Thomas Sprigg of Calvert County, Gent, and that the same day and before marriage the said John Beale entered into bond unto the said Thomas Sprigg in the sum of £500 sterling. The conditions being that whereas the said Jno. Beale shall shortly marry and take to wife Joana Tyler. widow of Robert Tyler, deceased, if he shall allow her to make her will and give and dispose of her lands, etc., this obligation then to be void.
