Strother, Mary x Harrison At a court held ., 2d day May 1765 .. will presented into court by JOSEPH HARRISON admitted to record and on motion of said Executor certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate thereof . === 1773-1780 King George County Deed Book 5 (Antient Press); Page 1193-1194a KNOW ALL MEN by these presents that I MARY {sic Martha} STIGLER, Widow and Relict of JAMES STIGLER, late of County of King George, deceased, in consideration of the natural love and affection which I have and bear unto my Son, BENJAMIN STIGLER as for the further consideration of his supporting me in a decent manner during my life, by these presents do remise release and quit claim unto BENJAMIN STIGLER and his heirs the real and personal Estate which was devised to me by the Last Will and Testament of my Husband, JAMES STIGLER, as will more fully appear by the said Will, and all the right title claim and demand of me said MARTHA STIGLER in the real and personal Estate aforesaid so that neither I the said MARTHA STIGLER or assigns or any of them shall claim or demand the said real and personal Estate; InWitness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 19th day of April 1776 Signed Sealed in the presence of JEDEDIAH PULLIN, MARTHA her mark STIGLER JAMES KAY, JOHN COLHAM No recording of this Deed of Gift is shown.)</p>
