Research Notes

[William Tate of North Carolina and Georgia](#) is not to be confused with this profile. That William Tate was born in North Carolina, married Elizabeth Hester Caldwell in Virginia, and died in Georgia. No sourcing found for North Carolina / Georgia profile.

Tate-4069 became a mixture of 'this' William Tate of Virginia and the other William of North Carolina and Georgia, so the profiles were separated.

There are multiple Census 1790 with William / Wm Tate / Tattes in Union, Lancaster, and Spartanburg.

Wife Elizabeth is found in 1800 Census as Elizabeth Tate in Spartanburg, may have been in 1810 census as Eliz McTate in Charleston and in 1820 as Miss Tate in Charleston. 1800 Census in Spartanburg has William's son William. Elizabeth may have married David Roberts.

William married Mary Roan in 1765. ?? They were the parents of at least 1 son. ^{[[citation needed](#)]}
