Tabitha Turentine seems to have married again after the death of Thomas Goolsby. Here are three records from The Diary of Robert Rose. Not everything here is correct because he assigns the wife of Thomas Goolsby born 1708, Lucy Bryant, to Thomas Goolsby born 1684. But her marriage to John Bond is mentioned three times in the book.

265 - Thomas Goolsby first lived in Goochland County, and his tithables assisted in clearing a road from Tuckahoe creek Mill to the ferry over Fluvanna (upper James) River at Manakm Town, in 1728. Nine months later they aided in clearing a road from the mill "to the main river road" known as Three Chop Road. Goolsby patented 1200 acres on Fluvanna River in 1732. His first wife is not identified; his second wife was Lucy Bryant, and six children were born. Thomas Goolsby and his third wife Tabitha Goolsby sold part of their Albemarle property to Leonard Ballou in 1746. Goolsby's will was proved in Albemarle March 10, 1746 by his widow and sons William and Thomas Goolsby (d. 1774). William Goolsby owned land on the south fork of Hardware River. Parson Rose's carriage either needed repairs after its mishap near Scottsville, or he was lending it with his servant to the Goolsbys. The widow Tabitha Goolsby married John Bond, August 16, 1750, with Rose as officiant. (See Note 822).

822-Tabitha Goolsby was the third wife and widow of Thomas Goolsby (d. 1746). Parson Rose noted the difference in the ages of Tabitha and John Bond who became one of the appraisers of the estate of Hugh Morrison in Culpeper County. Bond seems to have had a second marriage, later, for in his will proved in Culpeper in 1760, he named his wife Mary and two daughters, the will witnessed by George Hume.
